MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

Who Joins The University Women's Club: An Introduction

Women with a wide range of qualifications and achievements join The University Women's Club. A member may be a university graduate or have gained other qualifications from a professional body. Alternatively, she may have achieved distinction or experience in her field. Under the Young Members' Scheme a girl may be elected when she leaves school with the intention of pursuing a university degree.

Terms and Conditions of the Young Members' Scheme

Once a girl has been elected, she becomes a member for a lump sum payment. Membership lasts until the January following her 25th birthday. At that point she will be invited to continue membership without paying the normal entrance fee. The opportunity to join the Young Members' Scheme remains open for eighteen months after a girl leaves school, provided her principal feels able to support her application.

Returning Your Form

Your completed application form should be returned marked for the attention of the Membership Secretary. The Club does not acknowledge receipt of application forms.

The Membership Secretary will then write to advise you of the starting date of your membership. You will also be sent an invoice. Please do not send any money with your application.

When Your Young Members' Scheme Membership Expires

Shortly before the January following your 25th birthday, the Club will contact you to remind you that your membership is due for renewal. At that point you may continue your membership in the appropriate category without paying the normal entrance fee. For future reference, membership categories outside the Young Members' Scheme include:

Town Member	Member living within 50 miles of Hyde Park Corner.
Country Member	Member living not less than 50 miles from Hyde Park Corner (includes the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man).
Overseas Member	Member who is resident outside the United Kingdom.
Student Member	A student following a first degree course full-time at any University in the United Kingdom; valid until one month after the date of graduation.
Junior Graduate Member	Any graduate who joins before the age of 30.
Dining Member	A woman with qualifications for membership who may use the Club facilities, except those of residence, for a period of up to six months, without voting rights.
